

OVATION DESK SYSTEM AUSTRALIAN CONTENT

The Ovation Desk System was designed by Thinking Works' in-house design team, based in Sydney, Australia. The development cost of Ovation exceeded \$750,000.

During the design process, our team was conscious of sourcing Australian materials and components. Where Australian materials and components could not be sourced, the design team worked closely with our procurement team who have extensive knowledge and training, to find solutions that comply with our Modern Slavery Policies and Sustainability Policies.

Thinking Works was the first Australian furniture manufacturer to become a signatory to the UN Global Compact, and also voluntarily reports under the Modern Slavery Act. Breakdown of Materials and Components:

Metal components = 60% Australian

Plastic components = 0% Australian

Fixings = 100% Australian

Textiles = Typically 100% Australian depending on the specified fabric

Painting / Powdercoating = 30% Australian

Sub-assembly Labour = 100% Australian

Total Australian content based on dollar value = 67%
